[1] Have you considered studying abroad, but are not sure whether it's worth your time? If you ask anybody who has studied abroad, he or she will most certainly tell you that it is a life-changing experience and one of the most rewarding things he or she has ever done. Perhaps you're not certain what benefits you can obtain from a long stay in a foreign country. There is no better and more effective way to learn a language than to *be immersed in a culture that speaks the language you are learning. You're surrounded by the language on a daily basis and are seeing and hearing it in the proper cultural context. Language learning happens most quickly under these circumstances. Since studying abroad often puts you on a completely different continent, you are much closer to places you might otherwise not have the opportunity to visit.

[2] Cultural differences are more than just differences in language, food, appearances, and personal habits. A person's culture reflects very deep perceptions, beliefs, and values that influence his or her way of life and the way that he or she views the world. Students who experience cultural differences personally can come to truly understand where other cultures are coming from. Being immersed in an entirely new cultural setting is scary at first, but it's also exciting. It's an opportunity to discover new strengths and abilities, conquer new challenges, and solve new problems. You will encounter situations that are wholly unfamiliar to you and will learn to adapt and respond in effective ways. While abroad, you will meet not only natives to the culture in which you are studying, but also other international students who are as far from home as yourself.

[3] Students who study abroad return home with new ideas and perspectives about themselves and their own culture. The experience abroad often challenges (1)them to reconsider their own beliefs and values. The experience may perhaps strengthen those values or it may cause students to change or abandon (2)them and embrace new concepts and perceptions. The encounter with other cultures enables students to see their own culture through new eyes. Study abroad is likely to be much unlike what you are used to doing as a student. All in all, if you have a chance to study abroad, why don't you take advantage of it?
