[II] 次の英文を読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Have you seen raccoons before in Japan? They are exotic animals to Japan, but these days many of us must have seen some in many areas of Japan. Although you might have seen one, you probably did not recognize it. This is because raccoons are similar to raccoon dogs in appearance which are native of Japan. Despite their similarity, they have a little different appearance and characteristic features. Let us look through them and become able to tell one from the other.

Raccoons originate from North America and they belong to the raccoon family. Raccoon dogs, which are also known as *tanuki*, originated from East Asia, and they belong to an entirely different family known as "the canidae family" that both wolves as well as foxes belong to.

Raccoons are often between 40-60 cm in length, 6-10 kg in weight, while raccoon dogs are often measured at 50-60cm and weigh 4-10 kg. Raccoons have white ear rims, a black stripe from forehead to nose, and long white whiskers. Their feet are the same color as their bodies, and the shape of their paws is similar to those of humans'. On the other hand, raccoon dogs have black rims on their ears and black fur around their eyes and neck. They also have black whiskers, black feet, and dog-like paws.

The way raccoon dogs and raccoons behave is somewhat different as well. Raccoon dogs will live in pairs or small family groups. Raccoon dogs are also known to groom other members of their immediate family. We often see raccoons rest with members of their immediate family, but they may not groom their family members as often as raccoon dogs do. Raccoons tend to live alone. Raccoons are good at climbing trees and raccoon dogs digging holes in the ground. Raccoons, *araiguma* in Japanese, do not wash their food before eating. They are just trying to catch some fish in the water.

Raccoon dogs live to be only around eleven years old when kept in captivity, whereas raccoons can live up to twenty years in captivity. However, when these animals are in the wild, raccoons will only live for about two or three years, while raccoon dogs can survive for as long as seven years. This may indicate that raccoon dogs are better adapted to their natural environments.


Raccoons are sometimes associated with Rascal, a popular character name, and many of us might have a cute image of them. However, in reality, raccoons can be very aggressive toward people and we have to be careful. On the other hand, raccoon dogs are coward and they run away when they see us. Some people believe that raccoon dogs faint at loud noises.

Raccoons and raccoon dogs do have differently shaped bodies and characteristics, but you may have to be a close observer to notice the differences.

Miho, Japan

I don't think convenience stores need to be open 24 hours a day. The owners of the stores always have to have someone who works until late at night or through the night. It is now difficult to find the part-time workers who prefer working until midnight or early in the morning. If they cannot find those people, the managers themselves have to work for long hours. Working long hours is bad for their health. In addition, working through the night, people are more likely to be involved in crime. For the health and safety of the workers of convenience stores, they need not keep the stores open 24 hours a day.

Fon, Thailand

I strongly agree with the idea of keeping convenience stores open 24 hours a day. I have two reasons.

Firstly, they provide us with job opportunities. There are many 24-hour convenience stores in Bangkok, too. Many of my friends work there at night. They are college students and cannot work in the daytime on weekdays, but they can work at night. Some people even prefer working at night because they get paid more.

Secondly, 24-hour convenience stores could prevent crimes from occurring. They are always bright and they have workers and shoppers there, so they are safe even at night.

For these reasons, we should have more 24-hour convenience stores.
